## **POSTAL SCAM ALERT**

Please be aware of a postal scam that has been confirmed by Royal Mail. A card is posted through your door from a company called PDS (Parcel Delivery Service) suggesting that they were unable to deliver a parcel and that you need to contact them on 0906 661911 (premium rate number). Do not call this number as this is a mail scam originating from Belize. If you do call the number and you start to hear a recorded message you will already have been billed £15 for the phone call. If you do receive a card with these details, please contact Royal Mail fraud on 0207 2396655 or ICSTIS (the premium rate service regulator) at [www.icstis.org.uk](http://www.icstis.org.uk)
