Bishop of Rochester Vacancy

Members of the Vacancy in See Committee are trying to bring together a profile and person specification to aid the process of selecting a new Bishop and one of the most important parts of this process is enabling and encouraging people in our churches and the wider community across the Diocese of Rochester to give their views on what qualities we would be looking for in our new bishop. We hope that the views will take into account the current work being undertaken and the future challenges for the Church of England as well as the Diocese. Two executives from the Crown Nominations Commission, representing the Archbishops of Canterbury and York and the Prime Minister, will visit the diocese to interview a number of key people and to take part in a public meeting on the appointment.

The Public Meeting will be held at St Justus Church, The Fairway, Rochester ME1 2LT, on Thursday 12 November at 7.30 for 8.00pm.
