**FREEDOM PASSES** All current Freedom Passes will cease to work on 31 March. This process begins on 4 January and the application form is now available online and in Post Offices. It is a new form - which is the same as is used for new applications. The pass is normally renewed every two years to help prevent fraud but the new pass is different in a number of ways:

- your new style pass will be valid for five years
- for additional security, your new pass will include a photograph of you on the card itself rather than on a separate photocard, **so you will need to produce a passport-style photograph of yourself before you apply.**
- your new card will take up to 10 working days to arrive and will be sent to you in the post.
