Petition to save the Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme

This major source of funding is due to end on
31st March 2011. The Listed Places of Worship
Grant Scheme (LPWGS) enables listed places of
worship to claim back 100% of VAT incurred on
repairs and maintenance to the building,
professional fees and repair works to fixtures
such as bells and organs. The Scheme was
introduced in April 2001 and to date has paid out
over £100 million to places of worship across the
United Kingdom. To support the campaign to
