Every term Yohana has travelled by bus all the way from Chemba, a village in Kondo, Tanzania to Limuru in Kenya. He has been working very hard and for the last year has had to stay in Kenya because he didn't have money for the bus fare home. He now only has 2 terms left and we all trying very hard to raise the funds to help him finish his degree. This will have a profound affect on the community where he lives and encourage other young people to do the same.
